1. The general rules of the Junior Show apply in this section.
 2. Entry fee shall be \$4.00 per entry.
 3. **Junior members may exhibit a maximum of two steers.**
 4. Junior members may exhibit in more than one breed. However, they are limited to two entries per entry number.
 5. Steers may be purebred, crossbred or grade.
 6. Junior Beef Steers will be weighed Thursday, July 20 at 8:00 a.m., for weight and classification.
 7. All beef animals shall be owned and cared for by exhibitor since January 1st. with the exception of the purebred beef heifer calf which starts May 1st.
 8. Purebred calves, heifers and cows must have been registered in exhibitor's name. Application for registration papers must have been made on or before May 1st. **Registration papers must be available for inspection.**
 9. Each Junior member shall be permitted to make two entries in each class. **Maximum of two steers may be shown.**
 10. Age classification of beef cattle shall be as follows: Beef Steer-dropped after Jan. 1, 2016 and before Dec. 31, 2016. A record book shall be kept beginning Jan. 1, 2017, or before. Heifer calf - dropped after Aug. 31, 2016. Cow Calf class - cow & offspring any age owned by one exhibitor.
 11. No steer shall be shown - regardless of birthday - that does not have all of its milk teeth in place and no permanent teeth showing or evidence thereof.
 12. First and Second place calves in each weight group will compete breed championship.
 13. Stall fee of \$15.00 per head will be charged if animal are not entered in open class. **Exhibitor must bring their own bedding.** No straw or bark will be allowed. All cow-calf classes stall fee will be \$30.00. **These fees must accompany entry.**
 14. All animals are to remain in tents or barns until 7:00 p.m.
 15. **NO LIVESTOCK WILL BE RELEASED BEFORE 12:00 P.M. ON MONDAY, JULY 24.**
 16. No dogs will be allowed
 17. Livestock exhibitors desiring to use a portable generator during the fair must meet the rules set forth by the State Fire Marshall and the Iroquois County Fair Board. No generators will be permitted without first registering it with the fair secretary and securing a permit.
 18. Stalls will be assigned by the Dept. Supt. and will be 4 feet per stall fee paid. If their is space remaining after all stalls are assigned the Dept. Supt. will assign this to exhibitors for storage space. **Additional space may be purchased in 4' increments @ \$15.00 per space as long as space is available. A maximum of 2 additional spaces may be purchased per exhibitor. All additional space must be accompanied with fees and postmarked by July 11th so that adequate sized tents can be ordered. No refunds.**
 19. Exhibitors must clean stalls & tie-outs before leaving the fairgrounds after the livestock sale.

20. Only 1 fan per 3 head will be allowed.
21. Age classifications for beef cattle are listed in the white general rules.
22. In the Cow/Calf classes, the cow is only eligible for exhibition in that class. In other words, the cow may be shown only one time.
23. Show order will be as printed in book.
24. All animals (i.e., individual, herd or flock classes) shown in Junior Shows must be the property of the boys or girls showing them. If the same animals are shown in both the open classes and Junior Show, they shall be shown under the same exhibitor's name (for example, the father is not permitted to show an animal in the open class and the son or daughter show the same animal in the Junior Show).
25. Any pair or groups animals must be registered to one exhibitor.
26. **Entry of exhibits will be determined by the premium number only. Your description must match the premium number. If this differs we will go by the number you have written on your entry sheet.**
27. Any exhibitor washing an animal in an inappropriate spot other than a washrack will forfeit all their premiums.
28. Superintendent will have final discretion for space based on cattle present & stall available. Any stall that is not occupied with an animal will be assessed at the rate of \$15 per 4' increment.
29. **Once an animal is unloaded from the trailer and stalled, they may not be put back on the trailer until the end of the fair or they will be disqualified and forfeit all premiums.**
30. **ALL LIVESTOCK TRAILERS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIR GROUNDS AFTER UNLOADING BY 8:00 AM THURSDAY TO FREE UP PARKING.**

1. The general rules of the Junior Show apply in this section.
2. Entry fee shall be \$4.00 per entry.
3. Stall fee of \$8.50 per head will be charged if animal is not entered in Open Class.
4. All cattle exhibited must be accompanied by certificate of health.
5. Members may show more than one breed of dairy cattle.
6. Only two entries may be made in each class number.
7. All purebred dairy cattle must have been registered in the exhibitor's name.
Application for registration papers must have been made on or before May 1.
Registration papers must be available for inspection. This rule will be strictly enforced. No registration papers required for grade dairy.
8. Qualification of calves, heifers and cows shall be as follows: Heifer Calf - record starting May 1, 2017, born after July 1, 2016. Dairy Heifer - record starting on or before Jan. 1, 2017, born on or after Sept. 1, 2015 and before Sept. 1, 2016. Dairy Production - record starting on or before Oct. 1, 2016, cow may be born any time before Sept. 1, 2015. Production record is required.
9. Any dairy animal that is in production shall show in the production class regardless of age.
10. Age Classification of cattle in this department as listed in the white general rules.
11. **ALL EXHIBITORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO HELP CLEAN OUT BARN.**
12. No dogs allowed on the fairgrounds.
13. All animals (i.e., individual, herd or flock classes) Show in Junior Shows must be the property of the boys or girls showing them. If the same animals are shown in both the open classes and Junior Show, they shall be shown under the same exhibitor's name (for example, the father is not permitted to show an animal in the open class and the son or daughter show the same animal in the Junior Show).
14. **Entry of exhibits will be determined by the premium number only. Your description must match the premium number. If this differs we will go by the number you have written on your entry sheet.**

1. Entry fee shall be \$4.00 per entry and pen rent of \$8.50 per pen, maximum of 3 pigs per pen will be charged if exhibitors do not enter in Open Class. **The superintendents will assign and restrict pens on a space available basis.** If requested pens are not available, pen rent will be refunded. Pens for feed, supplies, etc. will be assigned by the superintendent on a space available basis.
2. All swine exhibited must meet state health requirements. **All swine will no longer require bloodtesting for pseudorabies and brucellosis in the state of Illinois.**
3. All pigs shall be farrowed on or after January 1st and before April 1st.
4. All pigs shall be property of the exhibitor.
5. Exhibitors may show more than one breed but only two entries per entry number may be made. No more than 2 monies will be paid in any class (a weight division being a class). A maximum of 24 Crossbred barrows could be shown if they fall into the 12 weight divisions.
6. All animals exhibited in the purebred classes (gilts or barrows) must be registered in the exhibitor's name or family name on or before June 1st.
7. **Registration papers must be presented at time of weighing. This rule will be strictly enforced.**
8. All barrows must have been fed by the exhibitor and have been the property of the exhibitor on or before June 1. Record books must be kept from June 1 to fair date.
9. Barrows weight groups will be established on Thursday after weighing.
10. ALL PUREBRED AND CROSSBRED PIGS must be ear notched but not fresh notched
11. All Gilts and Barrows will be weighted only on Wednesday. No re-weighs.
12. All purebred gilts must be weighed and will be shown according to age.
13. BEFORE UNLOADING check in with superintendents with your health papers and **the superintendents will assign the exhibitors their pens.**
14. NO LIVESTOCK MAY BE UNLOADED BEFORE 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, July 19. All hogs must be in place by 8:00 a.m., Thursday, July 20.
15. Hogs will be released at 12:00 p.m. Monday, July 24.
16. To facilitate pen clean out, hogs must be out of the barn by 4:00 p.m.
17. Exhibitors are responsible for tearing down pens, stacking gates and assist with barn cleanup.
18. **Entry of exhibits will be determined by the premium number only. Your description must match the premium number. If this differs we will go by the number you have written on your entry sheet.**
19. Any exhibitor washing an animal in an inappropriate spot other than a washrack will forfeit all their premiums. NO feeding in the washrack. Hogs brought to the fair MUST be clean upon arrival.
20. Barrows may not weigh over 290 lbs. to show for Champion.

The champion and reserve champion will be selected for each gilt and barrow breed. The champion in each breed will compete for Grand Champion. The reserve champion for the breed chosen as Grand Champion will show for Reserve Grand Champion.

1. The general rules of the Junior Show apply in this section .
2. Entry fee of \$4.00 per entry. Pen rent of \$4.00 per head will be charged unless rent is paid in Open Class.
3. Junior exhibitors may make two entries in each premium number. No more than two monies will be paid in any one premium number. i. e. You may show up to 14 wethers as long as there are no more than 2 in each weight division.
4. Lambs must be born after Sept. 1 of previous year.
5. Exhibitors are encouraged to castrate all surplus ram lambs to show in the Wether Class at the County Fair. All Wether Lambs must be weighed to be eligible to show. Ram lambs must have been raised by the exhibitor.
6. The rams of all lambs exhibited and all ewes exhibited must be registered in the exhibitor's name, and application for these registration papers must be available for inspection. This rule will be strictly enforced.
7. All lambs must be docked.
8. The judge will select the champion and reserve champion from 1st and 2nd place yearling ewe, ewe lamb and ram lamb classes for each breed and all other breeds.
9. Market ewe lambs CANNOT be shown in breeding classes.
10. **Entry of exhibits will be determined by the premium number only. Your description must match the premium number. If this differs we will go by the number you have written on your entry sheet.**
11. Pair of Breeding Lambs can be: Ram & Ewe or Two Ewes or two Rams.
