2. Entry fee shall be \$4.00 per entry. Stall fee - \$15.00 per head.
3. Each exhibitor may show only one horse or pony in each premium number. Show will be held rain or shine.
4. Horse and Pony records must be on a year round basis.
5. Each exhibitor is required to own, feed, care for, and train horse or pony exhibited.
6. Mare or gelding may be either purebred or grade.
7. All breeds will show together.
8. All horses or ponies will be tied in their stalls with the exception to nursing colts. **NO extra stalls may be purchased.**
9. No dogs allowed on fairgrounds.
10. **Entry of exhibits will be determined by the premium number only. Your description must match the premium number. If this differs we will go by the number you have written on your entry sheet.**
11. Any equine that is not sound (lame, open wounds, hernias, malnutrition, etc.) will not be able to be on the fairgrounds for the Iroquois County Fair. Superintendents have the right for any animal to be vet checked and excused should there be any discrepancies.
12. **Pine shavings will the ONLY acceptable bedding material.**
13. **ALL LIVESTOCK TRAILERS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIR GROUNDS AFTER UNLOADING BY 8:00 AM THURSDAY TO FREE UP PARKING.**

 2. Entry fee shall be \$4.00 per entry.

3. Pen fee shall be \$4.00 per animal.
4. Exhibitor may make two entries in each class.
5. No bucks allowed.
6. No horned dairy animals.
7. NO LIVESTOCK MAY BE UNLOADED UNTIL 4:00 p.m., Wednesday, July 19 and not later than 8:00 a.m. Thursday, July 20. All animals will remain for the duration of the fair and will be released after 12:00 noon, Monday.
8. Health regulations of the State of Illinois must be followed.
9. Entries must be made on entry blanks in fair book.
10. All entries must be mailed to Sam Ochs, Secretary, Box 301, Crescent City, IL. Entries close on July 11.
11. **Dairy Goats will be judged on Thursday, July 20, 8:00 a.m. & Meat Goats on Friday, July 21, 8:00 a.m.**
12. Any animals which possess any percentage of meat bloodline must be shown in the meat classes only.
13. Entry of exhibits will be determined by the premium number only. Your description must match the premium number. If this differs we will go by the number you have written on your entry sheet.
14. All meat and dairy wethers must be born on or after October 1st., 2015. There should be **NO VISIBLE SIGN OF A SCROTUM** and all castrations must be healed or the animal will not be allowed to show. **NO HORNS ALLOWED.**
15. Wood chips will be the only bedding allowed. **NO STRAW.**
16. Items used and stored in goat barn will be at the discretion of the goat superintendents.
